

The *Glorious Revolution Settlement*: A series of Acts passed by Parliament from 1689-1701 that limited the Monarch's powers but also limited Parliamentary authority as well!

- a. **Parliament Made the Law**, not the King (No vetoes, no King-Made law [big change!!!], *no taxes without consent of Parliament* [old principle, now extended]).
- b. **No Standing Army**
- c. Parliament to Convene at least Once every 3 Years and Elections at least once every 7 years (Free Elections, Free Debate).
- d. Annual Appropriations
- e. No Catholic Could be Monarch.
- f. Parliament Determined the Royal Succession.
- g. Judges Served by Pleasure of Parliament, not by the King/Queen.
- h. War Only by Parliament's Consent

The Glorious Revolution:

- 1) initiated era of parliamentary supremacy;
- 2) Parliament gained exclusive control over new taxes;
- 3) Parliament had right to audit how govt. spent money;
- 4) Royal prerogative powers curbed – prerogative courts were abolished;
- 5) **supremacy of common law courts.**

What made these work were

- 1) CREDIBLE THREAT – Charles I and James II had been dethroned;
- 2) **Parliament did not assume sole power.**
